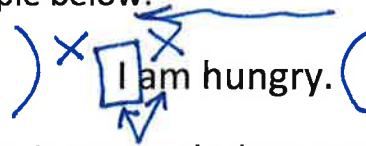


X-word Grammar Lesson Four Part A - Exercise One
