present-S FORM
5. His team had two games last weekend.
PAST FORM past
6. My wife and I go to some of his games.
present NO-S FORM
7. We went to a few games in April of this year.
past PAST FORM
8. His team won all four games that weekend.
past PAST FORM
9. Our son plays first base. -S FORM
